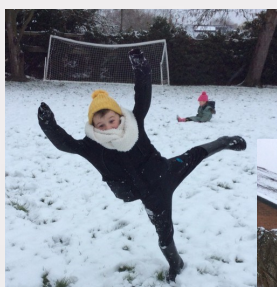


Summer Newsletter
