Pre-school News for Rothersthorpe School

We are delighted to announce that The DfE has granted us permission to change our school age-range from 3 years to include preschoolers. Our pre-school/reception parents open evening was really busy with a lovely group of parents.

We have received a lot of interest for our pre-school, as well as receiving more calls for reception class and other year groups. It's really exciting to be increasing our pupil numbers, and we are looking forward to the positive impact that this will have for everyone at our school. It's so important to sustain and further improve our school community for a range of families.

Breakfast Club and After School Clubs at Rothersthorpe

Our after-school clubs are proving to be very popular with around 50 places taken up each week. Pupil feedback is very positive—they are enjoying the activities on offer.

We are slowly increasing the numbers at breakfast club. However, we need at least 6 pupils per morning to support this provision. If you are thinking of changing your working hours in September, please think about using our provision. £4 per session is a very reasonable price.
