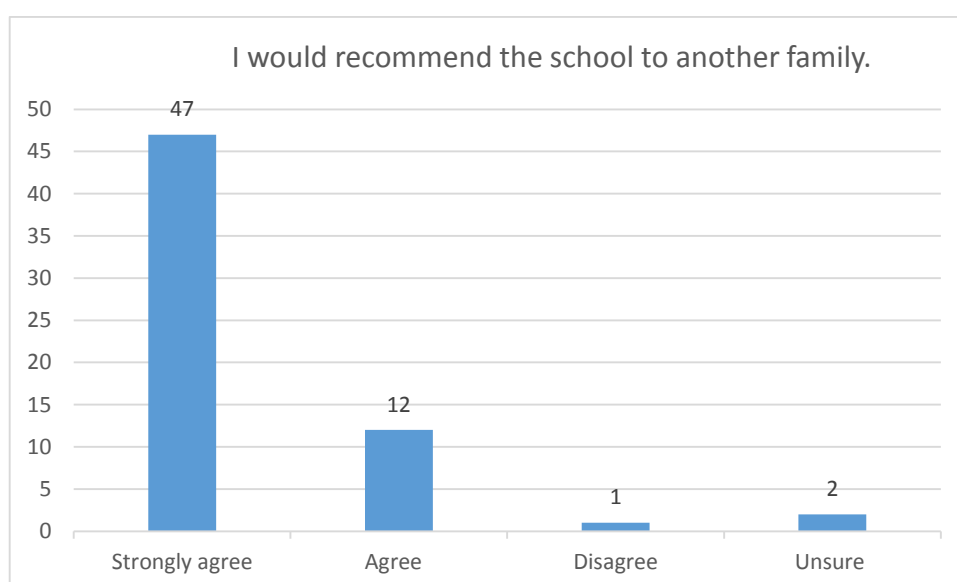
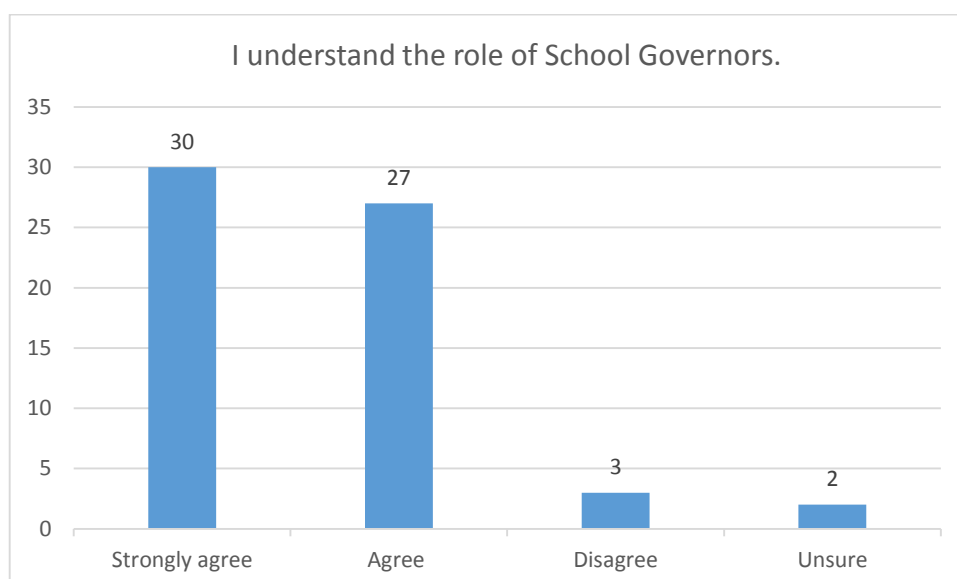












Some of the lovely comments received about what our school is doing well

Overall improvement suggestions

- 2 questionnaires disagreed with 'school provides a wide range of clubs'. 1 comment asked to also provide more 'non-sport clubs'.

School Response: We only have the equivalent of 4 teachers at our school to run clubs; there is a club after school on a rota every day except Friday, 2 morning clubs and 4 lunchtime clubs; our school hall is also used by the village. We provide art, gardening and cooking experiences in all classes during curriculum time.

Action: We have researched other types of clubs and will provide a Science club to replace the Premier Sports Club which has finished.

- 2 questionnaires disagreed with the school reward system for different reasons. 1 reason focused on their child not understanding the value. The other comment agreed with the reward system, but would like to be notified if their child is receiving an award in Friday's assembly.

School response: Children are aware if they have completed their achievement card so can inform their parents. As we only decide awards at lunchtime on Friday we don't have time to call all parents. We do however call parents for 'special awards' such as Amy's prize, KS1 Award, Ella Appleton or James Doherty sports award.

Action: None

- 4 questionnaires disagreed with 'receiving enough information to support their child at home'.

School response: We provide Reading, E-Safety and Maths workshops, assessment/new curriculum information and 3 parent consultations per year; class newsletters provide the topics being covered each term; monthly school newsletters often have ideas and tips to support your child at home; our website (www.rothersthorpeprimary.net) has many links to great websites and resources that support home learning such as Mathletics and Espresso. The Espresso school user name is: student24668 and password is: rothers

Action: Please ask your child's teacher for more support/information; they will happily provide it.

- 4 questionnaires commented they 'do not understand the role of the Governor'.
School Response: Information regarding the role of the Governor is on our school website and we publish information from Governor meetings in our monthly newsletter.
Action: None.
- 2 questionnaire gave a 'disagree that their child is happy at school'.
School response: We will support all families to ensure that their child is happy at school.
Action: If you have not already spoken to someone at school, please come forward. (To note: In the pupil questionnaires last month we had 'zero' children who said they were unhappy at our school. We hope this reassures you).

Thank you to everyone who completed a questionnaire, especially all the wonderfully positive and encouraging comments about our school community.

Both your positive, and improvement comments are extremely important to our school in ensuring we are the very best we can be for all our pupils, staff and community.

We received a total of 62 questionnaires out of 76 families currently at our school.
