
A special thank you to all the teachers and staff this week. Particularly Mrs Walker as she was the first teacher back at school supporting a group of children on the school site and others at home.

Also to Mrs Woods for supporting the Y6's who were so excited to be back! **You are amazing!**




### Class 3's Topic—The Stone Age



