
We are still looking for Santa for our 'fun run' this Friday afternoon. If Santa could please call the school office on—01604 830995. Thank you.


It's Strictly the Nativity

Our fun run this year is in aid of a local charity: <https://kidsaid.org.uk>

This charity supports children in Northamptonshire. KidsAid provides therapeutic support for children and young people. They do this by providing creative psychotherapies, including play therapy, art therapy, drama, dance and movement therapy.

Children can come to school on the **Friday in mufti with a Christmas Jumper**. They will also need **wellies, boots or old trainers in a plastic bag** to run around the field in. Plus their **coat** and maybe a **hat and gloves** if they wish. (The children will complete fun exercises in class if it rains).

The children will have a fun day at school, starting with their Christmas dinner at lunchtime, followed by the 'fun run' in the afternoon.

Children can bring into school 'any amount of donation' in a sealed envelope and put in the tray in their classroom. The overall aim is for the children to have fun, get a bit of exercise and raise a little money for other children in our local area. (We know that parents have many different commitments this year).



We are still looking for a Santa –please email school if you know a Santa who can visit our school from 1.30-2.30pm. Santa would sit in our outside amphitheatre and wave to the children whilst they complete their fun run.
